

ORDINANCE NO. 19-01-03

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 490 OF THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO REGARDING REGULATING PARKING ON STREETS DURING SNOW EMERGENCIES.

WHEREAS, an accumulation of two (2) or more inches of snow or the threat thereof constitutes a public hazard impairing transportation, fire and police protection and other vital activities of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle or, if parked, to allow a motor vehicle to remain parked or standing in any public street or alley during or after a snowfall in which there is an accumulation of 2 inches of snow or more.

SECTION 2. This prohibition shall remain in effect until such time as the street or alley has been plowed or the snow has been removed there from.

SECTION 3. A city street shall not be deemed to have been plowed until the lane of traffic nearest the curb has been plowed or the snow has been removed there from.


SECTION 4. Any motor vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance may be impounded or moved to an adjacent street by an authorized police officer. The owner of such vehicle shall be liable for any towing charges.

SECTION 5. No person shall cause or permit snow to be moved, placed or stored over or upon any portion of the paved right of way of any street from any location on private property.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency and shall take effect from and after its passage.
