ORDINANCE 20-07-01

AN ORDINANCE ABOUT DOGS TO BE ON LEASHES AND EXCREMENT **REMOVAL**

WHEREAS, The Council of Village of Sherwood deems it necessary to have an ordinance for dogs on leashes and excrement removal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, of the Village of Sherwood. State of Ohio, as follows:

Section 1: No person that is an owner, harborer or in control of a dog shall allow said dog to be upon the parks and recreation grounds owned or leased by the Village, or the highways, streets, roads, sidewalks, alleys, or other dedicated rights-of-way, without being restrained by a leash.

Section 2: Any person, who is an owner, harborer or in control of a dog, who takes said dog upon another's property, including the property described in section 1 herein, shall remove any excrement deposited by the said dog upon said property and dispose of it away from said property, and in a sanitary manner.

No dog excrement shall be deposited on any public street, sidewalk, storm Section 3: sewer, or anything else that is not a proper waste receptacle.

Section 4: Violation of this section is a minor misdemeanor. For which the violator may be fined up to one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00).

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
