

**ORDINANCE NO. 21-10-01**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE VILLAGE OF  
SHERWOOD, OHIO FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2022, AND DECLARING  
THE SAME AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS it is desirable that the compensation of Village official, employees, appointees and volunteers for the Village of Sherwood, Ohio for the year 2022 be set forth in an Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Sherwood, Ohio:

Section 1: That beginning with the first pay period year 2022, the compensation of Village officials, employees, appointees, and volunteers be as follows:

Section 2: Starting February 1, 2022, the positions Fiscal Officer and Village Administrator will become a combined position.

- Section 3: Any and all other benefits to which Village officials and employees may be entitled are as set forth in the Village of Sherwood's Employee Manual, subject to any and all amendments thereto.
- Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and applicable provisions of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 5: This Ordinance repeals any other ordinance inconsistent therewith.
- Section 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Village.
- Section 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect starting January 1, 2022.
