ORDINANCE 21-12-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO FOR 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Sherwood has previously passed an Appropriation Ordinance for the Village's fiscal year 2021;

And WHEREAS, because of financial circumstances which have arisen since the passage of the Appropriation Ordinance, said Appropriations Ordinance is no longer adequate to meet the fiscal needs of the Village of Sherwood;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Village of Sherwood Appropriations Ordinance for the fiscal year 2020 designated as Ordinance 21-01-01 hereby is amended to provide for appropriations to the respective fund hereinafter set forth as follows:
