ORDINANCE NO. <u>24-10-01</u>

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2025, AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS it is desirable that the compensation of Village official, employees, appointees and volunteers for the Village of Sherwood, Ohio for the year 2025 be set forth in an Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Sherwood, Ohio:

Section 1: That beginning with the first pay period year 2025, the compensation of Village officials, employees, appointees, and volunteers be as follows:

- Section 4: This Ordinance repeals any other ordinance inconsistent therewith.
- Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Village.
- Section 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect starting January 1, 2025.
