

ORDINANCE 24-10-02

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING PRIOR ORDINANCE 19-05-01, AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING EAST LAWRENCE STREET BETWEEN TAYLOR STREET AND HARRISON STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET WITH TRAFFIC PERMITTED TO TRAVEL WEST ONLY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under Ohio Revised Code Section 737.022(B)(9), the Council for the Village of Sherwood has the authority to regulate the direction of traffic on certain streets within the Village of Sherwood; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinance promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, and to review, interpret and amend its ordinance, rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherwood council, at a prior meeting of the Village Council held on July 15, 2019, approved Ordinance No. 10-19-05, An Ordinance Designating East Lawrence Street Between Taylor Street and Harrison Street as a One-way Street with Traffic Permitted to Traffic Permitted to Travel West Only Exhibit "A" Attached to this Ordinance, incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherwood council has determined that Ordinance 19-05-01 is no longer relevant or necessary and shall be rescinded;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SHERWOOD VILLAGE COUNCIL OF SHERWOOD, OHIO, DEFIANCE COUNTY, OHIO, as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to rescind and nullify Ordinance No. 19-05-01.

SECTION 2. RESCISSION. The Village Council hereby rescinds and nullifies Resolution No. 19-05-01


