RESOLUTION # 18-03-01

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ANTI-DISPLACEMENT AND RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PLAN FOR **THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD** TO PUT INTO EFFECT ON THE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND

WHEREAS, The **Village of Sherwood** will replace all occupied and vacant occupiable low-and moderate-income dwelling units demolished or converted to a use other than low-and moderate-income housing as a direct result of activities assisted with fund provided under the Hosing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and as described in 24CFR 570.488. HUD regulations have extended this requirement of the HOME program as well; and

WHEREAS, all replacement housing will be provided within three years of the commencement of the demolition or rehabilitation relating to conversion; and

WHEREAS, The **Village of Sherwood** will provide relocation assistance, as described in 24CFR 570.488, to each low-and moderate-income household displaced by the demolition of housing or conversion of a low and moderate-income dwelling to another use as a direct result of assisted activities; and

WHEREAS, Consistent with the goals and objectives under the CT, the **Village of Sherwood** agrees to provide substantial levels of assistance to persons displaced by HUD assisted programs and will further seek to minimize displacement of persons as a result of assisted activities; and

WHEREAS, The Anti-Displacement and relocation Assistance Plan in its entirety is attached and on file in the office of the **Village of Sherwood** and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the **Village of Sherwood**:

Section 1: That it is required the Village have in place an anti-displacement and relocation assistance plan to apply for funding for Community Development Block Grant programs.

Section 2: That the anti-displacement and relocation assistance plan be signed and dated by the village administrator.

Section 3: That the resolution number of this resolution be affixed to the anti-displacement and relocation assistance plan.
