

RESOLUTION 18-07-01

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING AN ADVISORY ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO SHOULD PROHIBIT THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA CULTIVATORS, PROCESSORS, AND RETAIL DISPENSARIES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Sherwood, Defiance County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: This Council hereby authorizes and directs the submission to the electors of the Village of Sherwood, Ohio, at an election to be held at the usual place of voting in the Village on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. of said day the question of whether the Village of Sherwood should prohibit the establishment and operation of medical marijuana cultivators, processors, and retail dispensaries within the Village of Sherwood, Ohio.

SECTION 2: It is the desire of this Council that the ballots presented to the electors of the Village of Sherwood shall be in substantially the following form:

Shall the Village of Sherwood permit the establishment and operation of medical marijuana cultivators, processors, and retail dispensaries within the Village of Sherwood, Ohio?

	Yes, the Village of Sherwood should allow the establishment of medical cultivators, processors, and retail dispensaries within the Village of Sherwood.
	No, the Village of Sherwood should enact legislation prohibiting the establishment and operation of medical marijuana cultivators, processors and retail dispensaries.

SECTION 3: Council unanimously waives the three-reading requirement and declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, such emergency arising out of the necessity to meet the deadline to place this question on the ballot for the November 6, 2108 general election. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.
