ORDINANCE NO. 25-11-01

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO TO
ENTER INTO AN EXCLUSIVE AGREEMENT FOR RESIDENTIAL REFUSE
COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES WITH WERLOR, INC., AND
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE SAID
AGREEMENT.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherwood, Ohio (“the Village”) desires to provide consistent, reliable, and cost-effective residential refuse collection services for its residents; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that entering into a single-provider exclusive collection agreement is in the best interest of the Village in order to protect public health, reduce roadway deterioration, ensure uniform standards, and stabilize service pricing; and

WHEREAS, Werlor, Inc., an Ohio corporation, has expressed willingness to serve as the exclusive residential refuse provider under the terms negotiated with the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sherwood that:

SECTION 1. Approval of Refuse Collection Agreement. Council hereby approves the residential refuse collection and disposal agreement with Werlor, Inc., for a term commencing on March 2026 and ending March 2029, with an option to renew for additional term(s) of 3 (three) years upon mutual written agreement of the parties.

SECTION 2. Exclusive Service Provider. Werlor, Inc. shall have the exclusive right and license to provide residential refuse collection, removal, and disposal services within the corporate limits of the Village throughout the term of the Agreement, as outlined in the document attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 3. Service Rates. The monthly cost per residential unit shall be as follows:

- Standard monthly residential service rate: \$ 19.50-65gal - \$21.50-95gal.
- Senior or single-occupant reduced rate (if applicable): \$ N/A
- Additional service options (bulk items, additional carts, tagging requirements, etc.):

All billing terms shall follow the procedures outlined in the Agreement.

SECTION 4. Authorization to Sign Agreement. The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to sign the Agreement on behalf of the Village of Sherwood. Minor modifications to the Agreement are permitted, provided they do not materially alter the terms of exclusivity, service scope, or cost structure without additional Council approval.

SECTION 5. Repeal of Prior Actions. Any ordinance, resolution, motion, or portion thereof previously adopted that conflicts with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law following passage after three readings.


