

**SHERWOOD VILLAGE
DEFIANCE COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE 26-08-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE
VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO FOR 2026 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Sherwood has previously passed an Appropriation Ordinance for the Village's fiscal year 2026;

WHEREAS, because of financial circumstances which have arisen since the passage of the Appropriation Ordinance, said Appropriations Ordinance is no longer adequate to meet the fiscal needs of the Village of Sherwood;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHERWOOD, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Village of Sherwood Appropriations Ordinance for the fiscal year 2026 designated as Ordinance 26-01-01 hereby is amended to provide for appropriations to the respective funds hereinafter set forth as follows:

FUND	ORIGINAL AMT.	ADD'T AMT.	NEW AMT.
Parks & Recreation	\$85,000.00	\$25,000.000	\$110,000.00

SECTION 2: Except for as modified above said Ordinance 26-01-01 shall remain in full force and full effect.

SECTION 3: This action hereby taken by the Village of Sherwood is declared an emergency, and this resolution shall be in full force and full effect as of the earliest date by law.
